Data provision



We would like to inform you that the provision of data marked with an asterisk (*) is necessary; therefore, any refusal to provide them will result in the impossibility of following up on your registration request.

By whom the data are processed and to whom they are transmitted



Your data are processed by employees and/or collaborators of the Joint Controllers, expressly authorized and instructed to process the data.

Your data are processed, on behalf of the Joint Controllers, by third parties who provide performance or services instrumental to the purposes outlined in this policy, to whom appropriate operational instructions are given and designated as data processors (such as, for example, the website company and marketing agencies and companies that offer mass mailing services and website maintenance).

Your data may be processed by third parties acting as autonomous data controllers entitled to receive the data, such as distributors, public authorities or professional firms.

Data transfer 🕏



Your data may be transferred by European Joint Controllers to countries outside the European Union (EU) or the European Economic Area (EEA). Where such countries have not been deemed adequate by the European Commission through a decision under Art. 45 of the GDPR, the "transfer tools" referred to in Art. 46 of the GDPR (such as standard contractual clauses) will be used, assessing whether "additional measures" are in place to ensure a level of protection substantially equivalent to that required by EU law.



6. Rights of the data subject



Data subjects may exercise the following rights against each Joint Controller:

- i) request access to data concerning them and information relating to the purposes of the processing, categories of personal data, etc.;
- ii) request the deletion of data if the Joint Controllers no longer have the right to process them;
- iii) obtain the rectification of inaccurate data or the integration of incomplete data;
- iv) obtain the limitation of processing (i.e. the temporary subjection of the data to the sole storage operation);
- v) receive the data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided (portability right);
- vi) withdraw any consent given at any time and object t to receiving commercial communications also by clicking on the *unsubscribe* link at the bottom of each e-mail, or through the personal area of the website;
- vii) access to the essential content of the Joint Controllers agreement mentioned in paragraph 1 above.

Finally, data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority in the Member State in which they habitually reside or work or in the State in which the alleged violation occurred.
